# A BILL

To terminate the designation of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan as a major non-NATO ally, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TERMINATION OF DESIGNATION OF THE IS-**  
4 **LAMIC REPUBLIC OF PAKISTAN AS A MAJOR**  
5 **NON-NATO ALLY.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Effective beginning on the date  
7 of the enactment of this Act—

8 (1) the designation of the Islamic Republic of  
9 Pakistan as a major non-NATO ally pursuant to

1 section 517(a)(1) of the Foreign Assistance Act of  
2 1961 (22 U.S.C. 2321k(a)(1)) or any other provi-  
3 sion of law is hereby terminated; and

4 (2) the President may not issue a separate des-  
5 igation of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan as a  
6 major non-NATO ally pursuant to section 517(a)(1)  
7 of such Act or any other provision of law unless the  
8 President submits to Congress a certification de-  
9 scribed in subsection (b).

10 (b) CERTIFICATION.—A certification described in this  
11 subsection is a certification that contains a determination  
12 of the President that—

13 (1) Pakistan continues to conduct military oper-  
14 ations that are contributing to significantly dis-  
15 rupting the safe haven and freedom of movement of  
16 the Haqqani Network in Pakistan;

17 (2) Pakistan has taken steps to demonstrate its  
18 commitment to prevent the Haqqani Network from  
19 using any Pakistani territory as a safe haven;

20 (3) the Government of Pakistan actively coordi-  
21 nates with the Government of Afghanistan to re-  
22 strict the movement of militants, such as the  
23 Haqqani Network, along the Afghanistan-Pakistan  
24 border; and

1           (4) Pakistan has shown progress in arresting  
2           and prosecuting Haqqani Network senior leaders  
3           and mid-level operatives.
