To abolish the Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Freedom for Farmers
- 5 Act of 2021".
- 6 SEC. 2. ABOLISHMENT OF AGENCY FOR TOXIC SUBSTANCES
- 7 AND DISEASE REGISTRY.
- 8 (a) Abolishment of Agency.—The Agency for
- 9 Toxic Substances and Disease Registry (in this section re-

- ferred to as the "Agency") is abolished effective on the date that is 1 year after the date of enactment of this 3 Act. (b) TERMINATION OF FUNCTIONS.—Except as provided in subsection (c)(1), all functions of the Agency shall terminate on the date specified in subsection (a). 7 (c) Transferred Authority.— (1) IN GENERAL.—Prior to the date specified in 8 9 subsection (a), the Secretary of Health and Human 10 Services (in this section referred to as the "Sec-11 retary") shall transfer the authority vested in the 12 Agency by section 104(i)(1)(A) of the Comprehen-13 sive Environmental Response, Compensation, and 14 Liability Act of 1980 (42 U.S.C. 9604(i)(1)(A)) as in effect on the day before the date of enactment of 15 16 this Act (relating to a national registry of serious 17 diseases and illnesses and a national registry of per-18 sons exposed to toxic substances) to an appropriate 19 agency within the Department of Health and 20 Human Services. 21 (2) Corresponding transfer of assets 22 AND PERSONNEL.—In connection with the transfer 23 of authority under paragraph (1), the Secretary may
